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**OBJECTIVE:** By the end of this lesson you will distinguish between the use of "As or like ".

• **AS:** The preposition "As" generally means "equal to "

**EX:** the heart functions as a pump for the blood.

(the heart = a pump)

Ex: Dr Callo worked as a research biologist for several years.

(Dr Callo = a .research biologist).

• The Preposition "like" : means " similar to".

Ex: The heart functions like a mechanical piston pump.

(The heart  $\neq$  mechanical piston pump).

## As vs Like

Ex: As a nurse, Marry assisted the surgeon in several operations.

(Marry is a nurse).

Ex: Like a nurse, her mother took care of her until she recovered.

(Her mother is not a nurse but she worked in the same way as a nurse)

Ex: As all children young birds depend on their parents for food.  $\leftarrow$  (Incorrect)

## ( all children ≠ young birds)

 $\rightarrow$  Like all children, young birds depend on their parents for food.  $\leftarrow$  (Correct)

- The nose functions ......both a filter and a warmer of incoming air.

- Galileo worked ......a mathematics professor before the invention of the telescope that enabled him to make his famous discovery.
- A glacier acts .....both a file and a plow at the same time
- The sun.....other stars, was formed 4.6 billion years ago from a cloud of hydrogen gas.
- Many modern appliances .....dishwashers, consume a lot of energy.
- ......Mars, the planet Neptune has two satellites.
