Text A.

During the nineteenth century, the discovery that cells reproduce themselves by dividing into two illuminated the very origin of cells and became a cornerstone of the cell theory (.....).

Today, research on cell division flourishes because an improved understanding of its mechanism could lead to improvements in the treatment of diseases such as cancer (.......) and because we are fascinated by the cytoskeletal 'nanomachinery' that is responsible for mitosis and cytokinesis (......).

Text B.

Novel pneumonia caused by coronavirus was reported in the Chinese city of Wuhan in December 2019(......). The virus was then identified and named as a severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) or COVID-19. COVID-19 is an acronym that stands for coronavirus disease of 2019 and is given by the World Health Organization (WHO) (......).

The International Committee on Taxonomy of Viruses (ICTV) suggested that this novel coronavirus was named SARS-CoV-2 due to the phylogenetic and taxonomic analysis of this novel coronavirus (......).

According to the Johns Hopkins Coronavirus resource center (coronavirus.jhu.edu), as of January 2021, a total of about 98.0 million cases along with 2.0 million deaths related to COVID-19 have been confirmed worldwide. This highlights the severity of COVID-19 infection, and also the nonavailability of effective therapy to date.

By the year 2000, the volume of wastewater produced could double from 1990 levels to almost 78 billion tons (......).
